- The test could be much more than the scenario

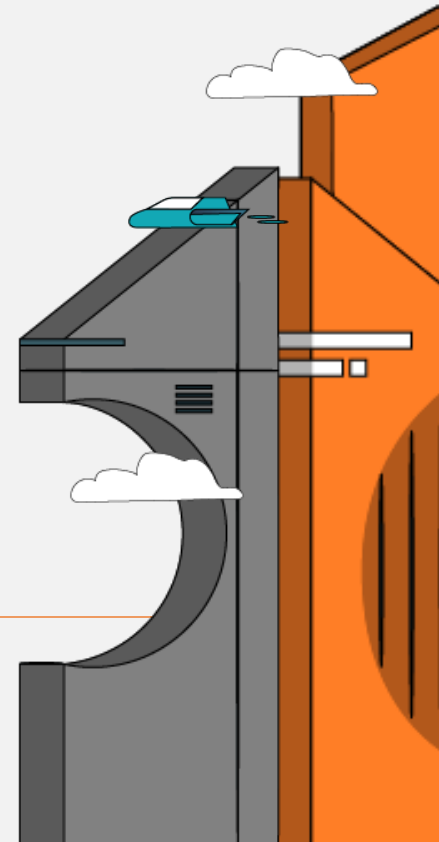
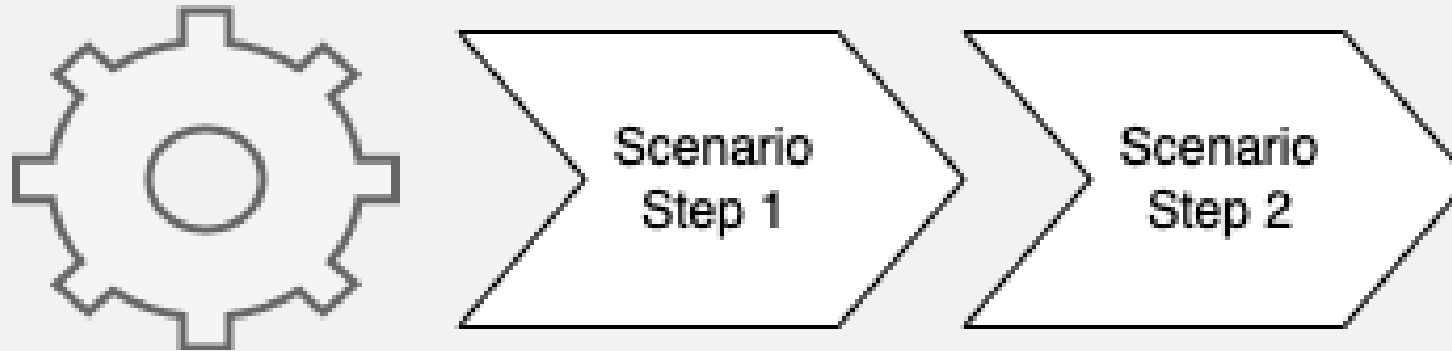
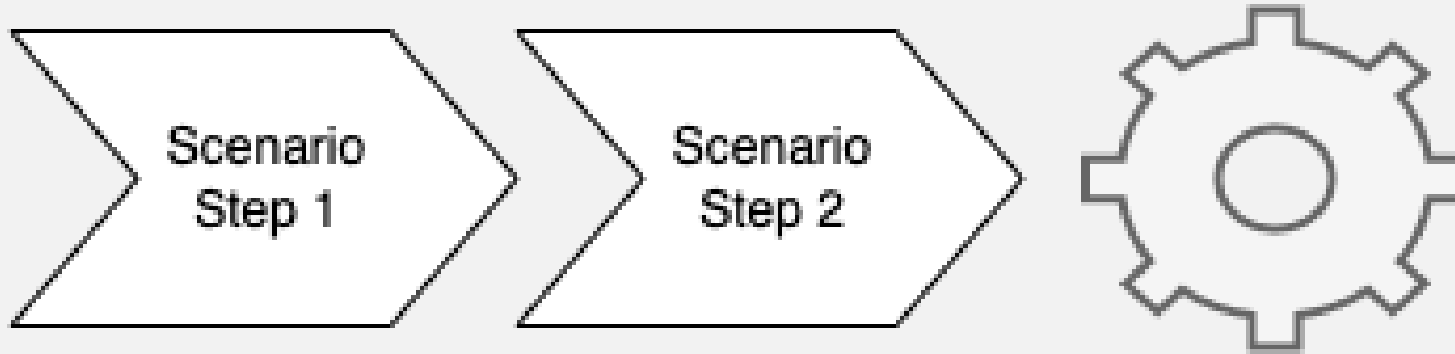

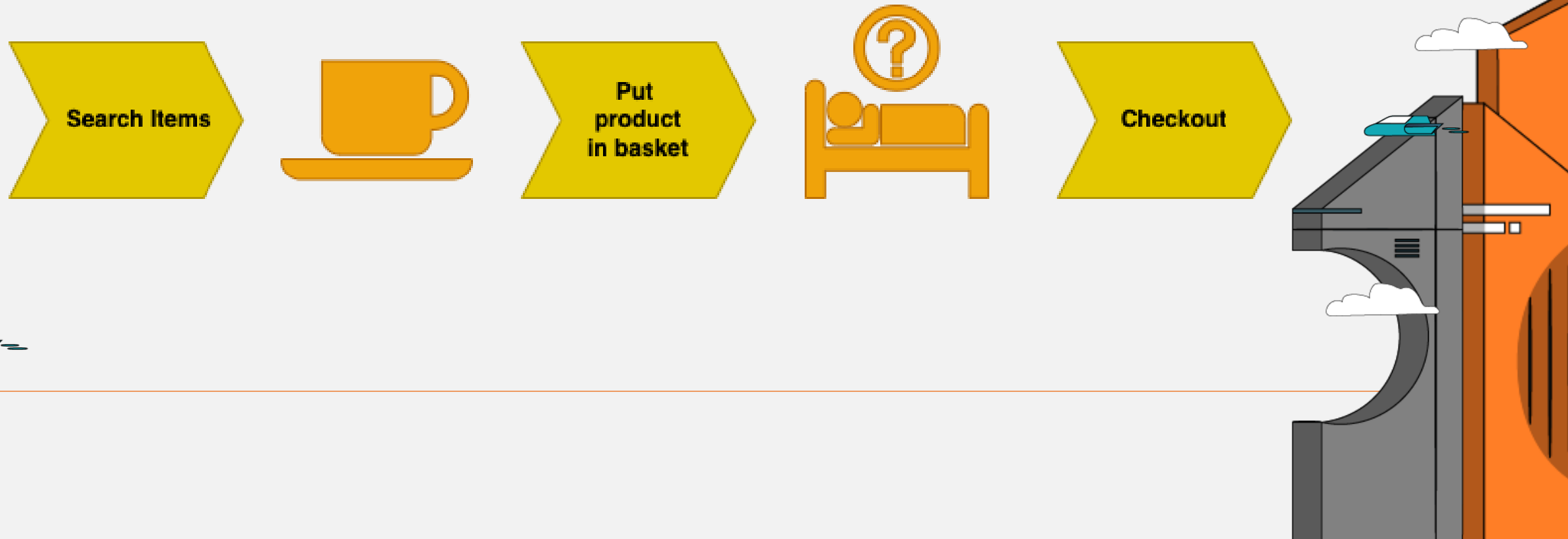
- Data changes between versions

- No dedicated test scenarios



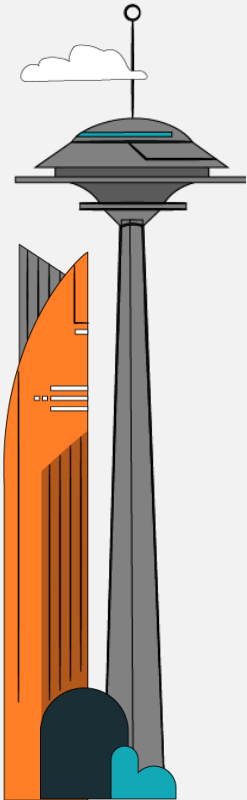

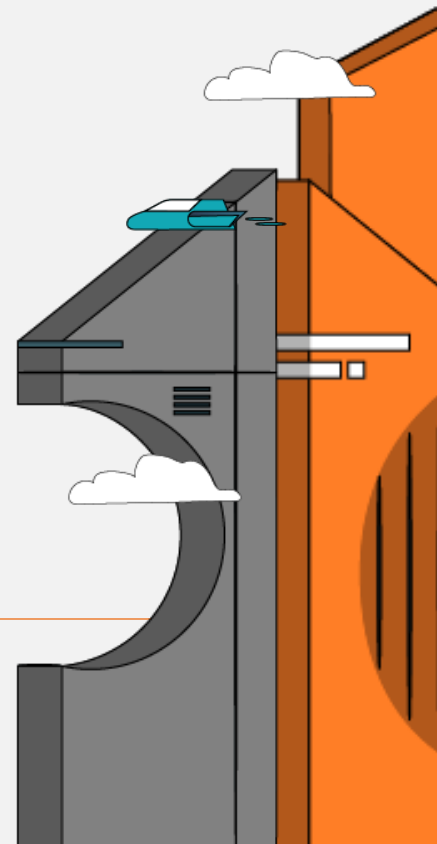
# Event-Based Mutations

    - Data surges



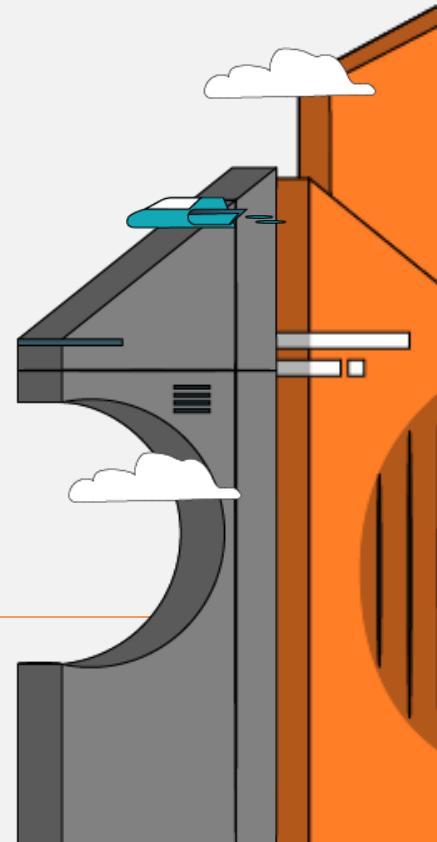

- Non-Interruptive



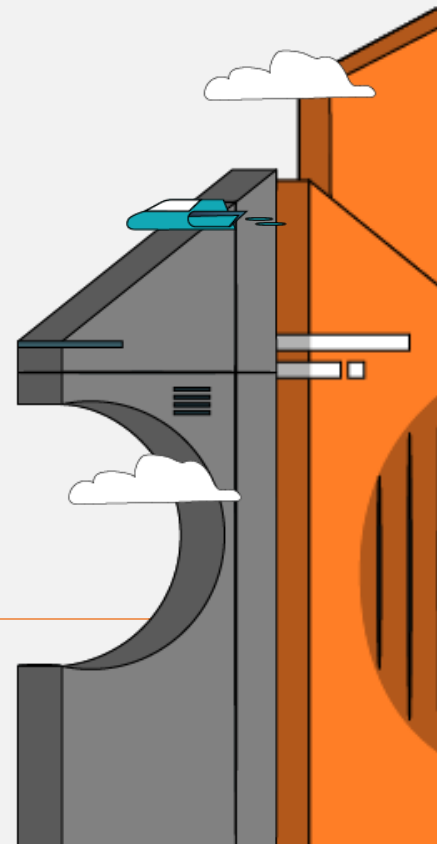
# Interruptive Events

- Some upgrades



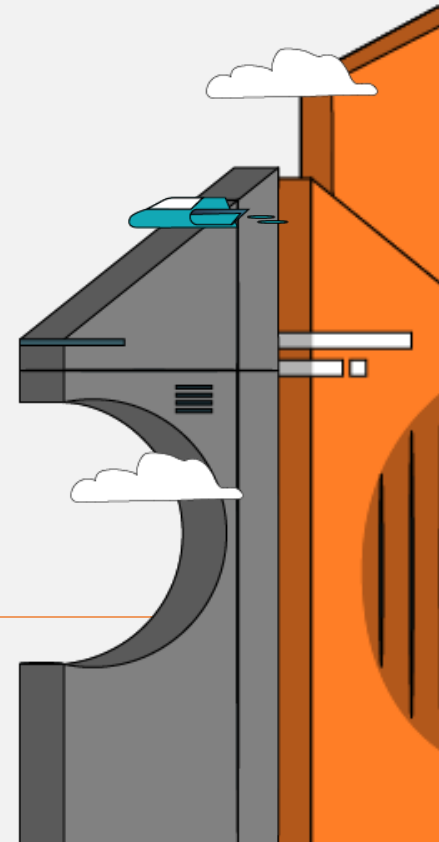
# Interruptive Events: Challenges

- Carry on your scenarios after the interruptions



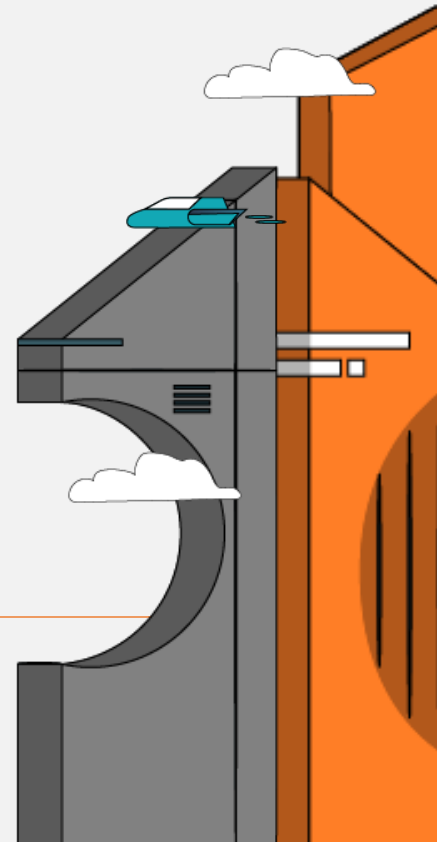

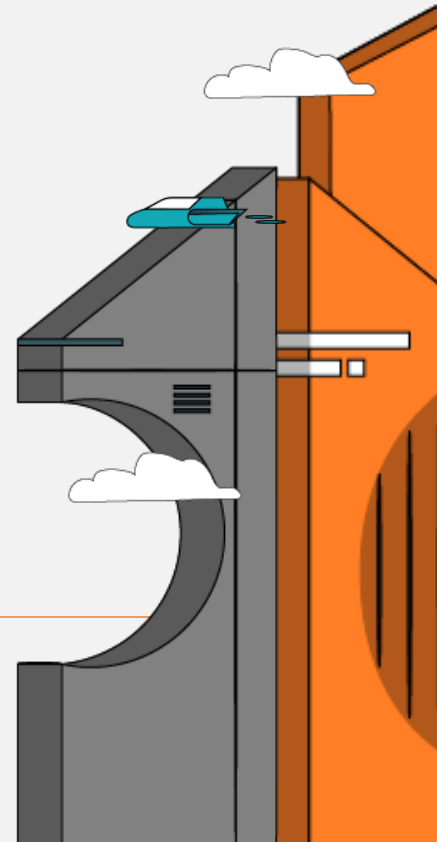
# Non-Interruptive Events

- Often Unexpected
- Chaos Testing
- But not always chaotic






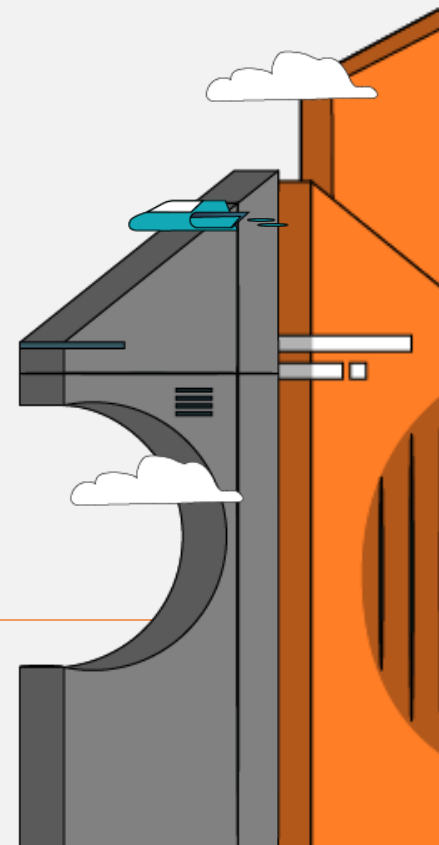
## Non-Interruptive Events: Challenges

- Wrapping the scenario around the event



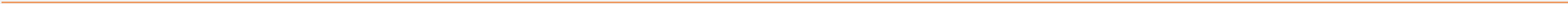
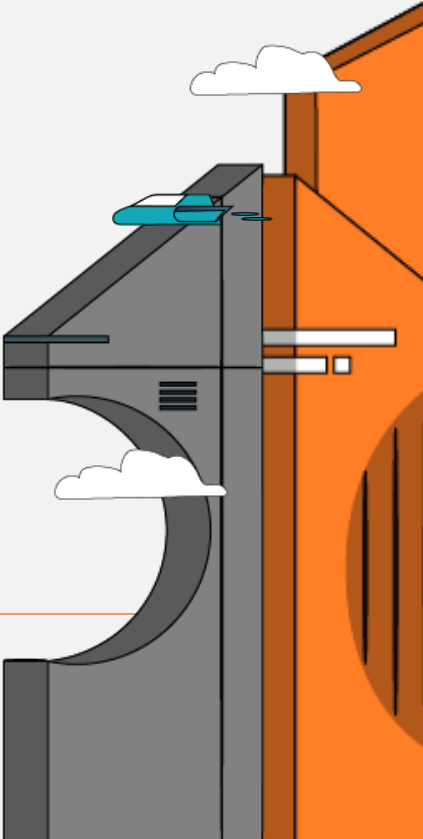

# Order Breaking Mutations : Dependency Map

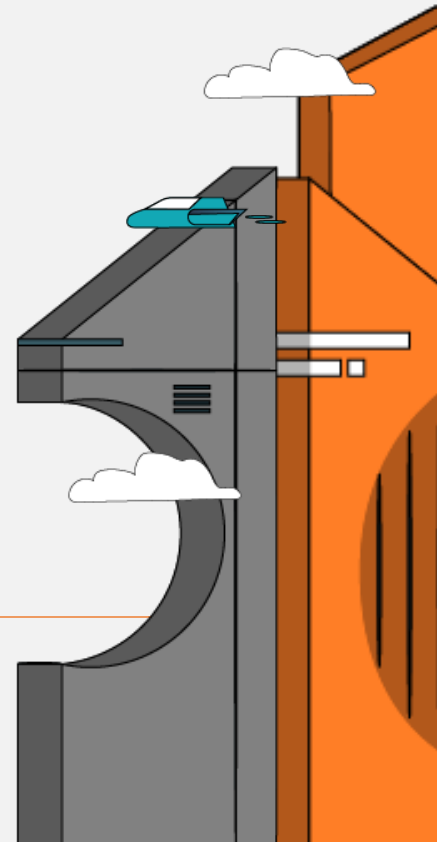

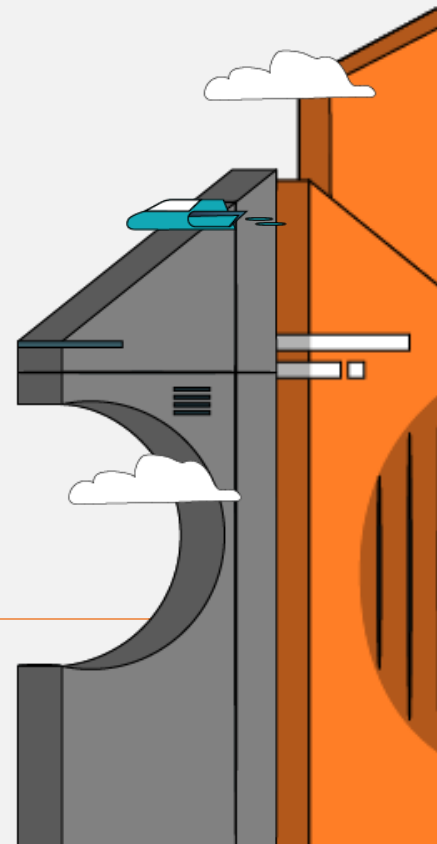
# Conclusions - Takeaways

- Start asking your product questions



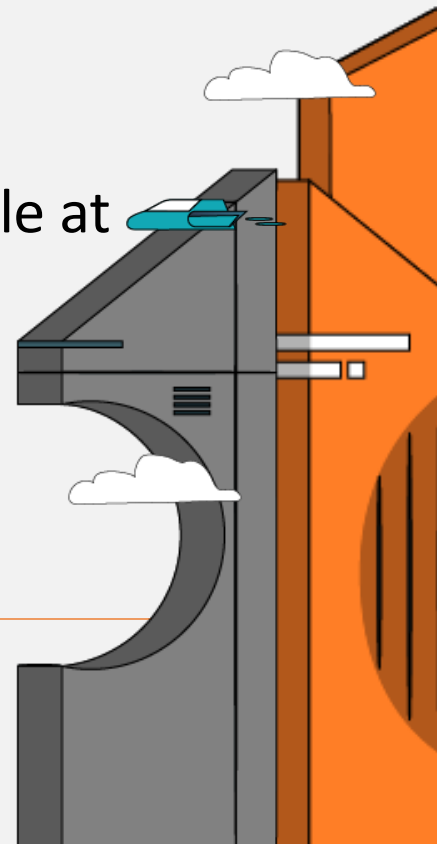
# Conclusions - Evolution

- A Cucumber implementation

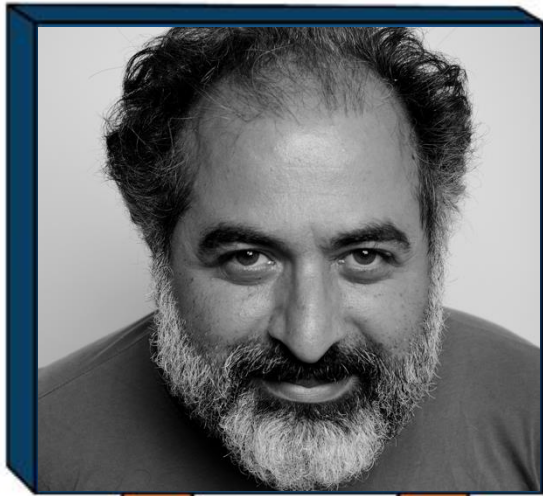
